

Small Business Superannuation Clearing House

Update 9th March 2018

If you are a user of the ATO's SBSCH house you would have been advised that to continue using the SBSCH you will need to link this to your MYGOV account. (ATO Link below)

However, if you are using a Withholding Payer Number (WPN), they have not provided direct access (only ABN users). To continue to use the SBSCH please contact 1300 660 048. Have your tax file number and clearing house details ready and they will assist you to make the payment. Note: When calling, be persistent on this advice, as some ATO personnel are not up to speed with this issue. (See this information link below)

Alternative process to access the SBSCH service

If you identify as one of the Small Business Superannuation Clearing House (SBSCH) users below, call us and we'll process your transactions manually.

- > non-individual WPN holders including school canteens, sporting clubs, international entities and embassies
- > WPN holders who use a BAS agent
- > individual WPN holders who are represented by another person such as a family member or trustee
- > all others who are ineligible to access our online services via myGov or unable to obtain an AUSKey.

If your tax agent manages your super obligations, this can continue as they will access the SBSCH through their online channel.

Next step:

- > Phone **1300 660 048** and have your tax file number and clearing house information ready.
